The series number '634' is deceptive. No books were published in this series until 1978. The series was probably allocated this number because many titles in series 633 were later reprinted in this series and initially kept their 'first published' date. They were joined by a few other titles which were considered anomalies (such as 'Understanding Maps' and 'London') in something of a tidying-up exercise. Because these books are later than the scope of this guide (I have little interest in most books published after the mid-70s) I shall only list the titles to look for and add a few pointers to editions in the 'distinguishing features' column. In most cases the concept of a first edition is pretty meaningless in books of this era. But bear in mind that, after 1983, books were issued with shiny, laminated covers so all the books in this series were first published with matt covers except where mentioned.
